

The Epic of Gilgamesh (c. 1800 BCE) contains striking parallels, predating the biblical Genesis account.




Science Finds Zero Evidence of a Global Flood
Uninterrupted data from ice cores, tree rings, geology, and animal distribution contradict a worldwide flood.




Ancient Civilizations Survived Uninterrupted Through the "Flood" Era
Egyptian, Sumerian, and Perusian civilizations show no evidence of being wiped out around 2400 BCE.



Mormon Scriptures Cement the Flood as Literal History
The Book of Mormon, Book of Moses, and Book of Abraham all describe a literal, worldwide flood.



The "Garden of Eden in Missouri" Makes a Global Flood Essential
Joseph Smith taught Adam & Eve lived in Missouri, requiring a global flood to move Noah to the Old World.
